Johanna "Jenny" Lind was a renowned dramatic opera star in Europe before touring the United States from 1850 to 1852 under the promotion of P.T. Barnum. She was the inspiration for Hans Christian Andersen's story, The Ugly Duckling. Known as much for her faith and philanthropy as for her voice and acting ability, Lind overcame a difficult childhood to bring respectability to female stage performers, in an age when it was considered an evil profession. JoAnn Peterson of Kingwood, who portrays Lind in first person, is an accomplished vocalist and will sing during her program.
